Gross Motor

- ☐ Animal-walk race across the room
- ☐ Balance along a tape line
- ☐ Toss beanbags into a basket
- ☐ Freeze dance to music
- ☐ Pillow & cushion obstacle course

Sensory & Science

- ☐ Water play, pour, scoop & measure
- ☐ Sink-or-float test in a bowl
- ☐ Nature walk & collect treasures
- ☐ Scoop & dig in a rice sensory bin
- ☐ Watch ice melt in warm water

Art & Music

- ☐ Finger or sponge painting
- ☐ Color & scribble freely
- ☐ Make a shaker instrument
- ☐ Tear paper & glue a collage
- ☐ Clap & keep a rhythm together
