Work with the walls, the doors, and the space you forget you have.

HOME / ROOM

DATE

Go room by room. Declutter first, then claim vertical, under, and behind-the-door space before buying anything.

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Small spaces reward editing over adding. Give every item one home, use the height of the room, and let doors and the undersides of furniture do quiet work.

Entryway & Doorways

catch drop zones

- ☐ Add wall hooks for coats & bags
- ☐ Over-door organizer for shoes
- ☐ Slim console or wall shelf for keys/mail
- ☐ Basket for library books & returns
- ☐ Bench with hidden seat storage

Living Room

dual-purpose furniture

- ☐ Storage ottoman for blankets & remotes
- ☐ Floating shelves up the wall
- ☐ Bins inside the TV console
- ☐ Behind-the-sofa slim table for chargers
- ☐ Cord & cable clips out of sight

Kitchen & Dining

go vertical

- ☐ Magnetic strip for knives & spices
- ☐ Over-sink board to expand counter
- ☐ Cabinet-door rack for lids & wrap
- ☐ Stacking shelf risers inside cabinets
- ☐ Hanging rail with S-hooks for utensils

Bathroom

use the height

- ☐ Shelf or cabinet above the toilet
- ☐ Tension rod + baskets under the sink
- ☐ Suction caddy inside the shower
- ☐ Over-door hooks for towels & robes
- ☐ Drawer dividers for small toiletries

BINS NEEDED

BUDGET

Finish the bedroom, closet, office nook, and kids' zones, then plan the linen closet shelf by shelf below.

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Bedroom

reclaim under & up

- ☐ Under-bed bins for off-season clothes
- ☐ Bed risers to add hidden height
- ☐ Floating nightstand or wall shelf
- ☐ Over-door jewelry / accessory rack
- ☐ Headboard with built-in shelving

Closet & Wardrobe

double the hang

- ☐ Add a second lower hanging rod
- ☐ Slim velvet hangers to gain space
- ☐ Shelf dividers for folded stacks
- ☐ Hanging shelf for shoes or bags
- ☐ Top-shelf bins for luggage & spares

Office Nook

a desk in no room

- ☐ Wall-mounted fold-down desk
- ☐ Pegboard for supplies & cords
- ☐ Vertical file / mail sorter
- ☐ Rolling cart that tucks away
- ☐ Closet converted to a work station

Kids & Toys

low, labeled, contained

- ☐ Low open bins kids can reach
- ☐ Picture labels for sorting
- ☐ Wall book ledges instead of a case
- ☐ Over-door pockets for small toys
- ☐ Toy rotation bin stored up high

Linen Closet Zone Map

top shelf down, assign a zone to each level

TOP
SHELF

Rarely used & seasonal, guest bedding, spare blankets, holiday linens. Store in labeled bins so they lift down easily.

UPPER
SHELF

Bath towels, roll instead of fold to fit more and grab one-handed. Keep your best set at the front.

MID
SHELF

Hand towels & washcloths, corral in an open bin. Add a small basket for extra soap & toilet paper.

EYE-LEVEL
SHELF

Sheet sets, tuck each folded set inside its matching pillowcase so complete sets stay together.

LOWER
SHELF

Toiletry backstock, shampoo, first aid, cleaning refills in labeled bins you can pull out like a drawer.

FLOOR

Bulky & tall items, laundry basket, step stool, vacuum, or an extra pillow. Keep a clear path.
